**CALGARY, AB -** In addition to the exciting special presentations, features and documentary films screening at the 2025 Calgary International Film Festival, the shorts line-up is always a fan favourite, with shorts packages curated for a diverse range of interests. With over 100 shorts screening from **September 18 – 28, 2025,** audiences can expect varied film styles, international viewpoints, local gems and diverse stories from around the world, including **HOW TO SHOOT A GHOST**, directed by **Academy Award-winner Charlie Kaufman**, which will have its North American Premiere, the Canadian Premiere of John Kelly's **RETIREMENT PLAN,** which just won awards at both SXSW and Palm Springs ShortsFest, and two-time Academy Award-nominee Cordell Baker's **GOOD LUCK TO YOU ALL** will screen at CIFF 2025 - and so much more!

"Our team is so excited about the short film lineup this year. We've put in a lot of work to balance between newer filmmakers and more established ones," said Adam Keresztes, CIFF's Lead Shorts Programmer. "There are many fantastic films from alumni directors, a handful from Oscar®-nominated and Oscar®-winning directors, and many first-time CIFF selected short filmmakers.
