Announcing CIFF's 2022 Jury Award Winners!

Calgary, AB - Each festival season, the Calgary International Film Festival welcomes esteemed jury members from across North America to recognize the year's most exceptional feature and short films, all of which are screening at the festival until October 2, 2022. With 11 awards and over \$25,000 in cash and prizes, CIFF is thrilled to announce this year's winners!

Please note, CIFF has added additional screenings of the winning films, as indicated below each winner.

\$10,000: RBC Emerging Canadian Artist Award

This juried award is given to the Canadian director who creates the best first or second narrative feature film.

Grand Jury Prize: I LIKE MOVIES, directed by Chandler Levack

The winner also receives a 50% scholarship to Vancouver Film School valued at up to \$18,000 and a \$2,500 Gift Card from William F. White International, Inc. towards the winner's next project.

"IS THIS THE PLACE provides a contemplative and patient film that never rushes. The cinematography is very deliberate and the shots are beautifully composed; each one feels necessary and well thought out without being obvious. As our lead character interacts with the various other characters and places throughout the film, the story reveals itself without ever leading the audience too forcefully. The emphasis remains on the character and not the plot, allowing the audience to make their own conclusions about the details of what is in the coffee canister and why it's a difficult decision to figure out where to open it. That can be a risky choice as a filmmaker, but it pays off here with an interesting and understated film."
