WORLD PREMIERE FILMS AT CIFF 2025

Announcing the first wave of films at this year's festival, including appearance & performance by Canadian icon BIF NAKED!

Calgary, AB – The Calgary International Film Festival, presented by Servus Credit Union, unveils the first wave of films to be screened at CIFF 2025 from **September 18** – **28**, including world premiere titles and celebrity appearances. The festival will kick off its DAY ONE program with the Spotlight+ screening of **BIF NAKED**, a raw and unfiltered look at the life of one of Canada's most iconic and fearless musicians. Bif Naked will be on the red carpet in advance of the screening, with a Q&A and musical performance to follow.

"Every year we get so excited about the lineup and can't wait for audiences to dig into all the gems we've found. We're always looking for a unique mix from around the world, with something for everyone. This year we have a record number of world premieres, with nine so far in the line-up, and we've also made sure to seek out some exciting family-friendly films. And of course, we always love celebrating all the hard work of our local filmmakers, with nine feature films in the Alberta Spotlight section this year," said Brenda Lieberman, CIFF's Lead Programmer.

"At this year's festival we will kick things off with our DAY ONE films, with five features from different sections at Contemporary Calgary and Globe Cinema, with one big after-party. We're all big fans of Bif Naked, who will take centre stage with our Spotlight+ screening and performance. Highlights from our Special Presentations and Alberta Spotlight sections will get audiences hyped for their next 11-days of movies, guests, Q&A's, socials, panels, and so much more."

Tickets for the Spotlight+ screening of BIF NAKED will be \$35 each, and will include access to the DAY ONE after-party. These tickets go on sale to the general public on August 14 alongside tickets for CIFF's annual Trailer Party, which takes place on August 27 at 6:30 p.m. at Globe Cinema.
